ETIQUETTE AND CARE OF THE COURSE

As party organiser you may wish to share the following with your group.

SLOW PLAY!!

Be ready on the first tee and stand
With ball on tee and club in hand

On the next tee saving time's not
hard
One drives off and one marks the
card

Don't leave trolleys in the way
Or those behind must wait to play

Keep up with players ahead of you
To lose a hole is strictly taboo!

Lost ball? Where is it? Not a clue?
The following players you must call
through

In Stableford if you cannot score
Pick up your ball and putt no more

If a slow coach you must stay
Then please start later in the day

PITCHMARK DISEASE!!

Visitors should not be alarmed at the recent outbreak of Pitchmark Disease on the greens.

Although this disease can be very upsetting, it is curable. It need not be contagious provided adequate precautions are taken.

Visitors and members alike are advised to:

- Carry a pitchmark repairer at all time
- Attack the disease thoroughly whenever an outbreak appears
- Warn playing partners of infection
- Eradicate carriers of the disease when identified

This disease can be contained provided all golfers are indoctrinated and take appropriate precautions.

In addition to repairing pitchmarks, raking bunkers and replacing divots, players must ensure that fellow players do likewise. Failure to do so makes them equally responsible.

MOBILE PHONE POLICY

CLUBHOUSE

For the comfort and consideration of others, mobile phones cannot be used on the first floor of the clubhouse. They may be used in the car park and locker rooms. Mobile phones with a ring function should be switched off when in a prohibited area. It is recognised that this is not always possible and provided the phone is either switched off immediately or answered in a permitted area, the ringing will not be considered an offence, although the answering would.

COURSE

Mobile phones are not to be used on the golf course. However, for reasons of safety we recommend that mobile phones are carried on the course, but they must be switched off.

It is the responsibility of the PARTY ORGANISER to ensure that all members of their party are aware of and adhere to our Mobile Phone Policy.

GOLF BUGGY HIRE

We have up to six buggies available for hire which can be booked in advance. A deposit may be required when booking a buggy and individual names must be given for each booking.

Knaresborough Golf Club has a strict buggy policy that must be adhered to by all golfers that use a golf buggy on the course.

Golfers who are disabled within the meaning of section 6 of the Equality Act 2010, have priority when booking a golf buggy. Prior booking is essential to guarantee the availability of a buggy.

DRESS CODE

The policy of Knaresborough Golf Club is to set a smart yet congenial atmosphere alongside the traditions and heritage of our great game. Please assist everyone concerned by ensuring that you and your party adhere to this policy when at the Club.

It is expected that all Members, Guests and Visitors to the Club be appropriately and smartly attired at all times.

ON THE GOLF COURSE

Smart casual clothing, including collarless shirts if specifically designed for golf, which may include tailored shorts. Shirts must be tucked in at all times, trouser bottoms may not be tucked into socks and when caps are worn the peak must be to the front.

IN THE CLUBHOUSE

The minimum standard is smart, casual, clean clothing at all times – no golf shoes, spiked or otherwise, hats, wet or soiled clothing or golfing rainwear.

UNACCEPTABLE DRESS

The following items of dress are deemed unacceptable anywhere on the course or premises:

- Stockinged or bare feet
- Sandals or shoes must not be worn without socks
- Football/Rugby shirts and shorts, beach shorts, training shoes
- Tee shirts, sleeveless or collarless shirts unless specifically designed for golf
- Denim garments and 'jean' style trousers with riveted pockets
- Combat style trousers or shorts

It is the responsibility of the PARTY ORGANISER to ensure that all members of their party are aware of and adhere to our Dress Rules. Any visitors who overlook these requirements will be requested to make the necessary changes.

PACKAGES

A. 18 HOLE PACKAGE

**Price per person £42.50
(Minimum 12 players)**

18 holes of golf morning or afternoon including a 2-course meal served following your round. Coffee and bacon rolls or soup and sandwiches can be provided before play at extra cost (see below).

B. FULL DAY PACKAGE

**Price per person £52.50
(Minimum 12 players)**

Coffee and bacon rolls on arrival with a soup and sandwich lunch served in the clubhouse after a morning 11 holes. Followed by a further 18 holes after lunch in time for a 2 course evening meal served in the dining room. A 3 course meal can be provided at extra cost (see below).

C. GOLF ONLY 18 HOLES

**Price per person £32
(Minimum 12 players)**

Coffee/Bacon Rolls Add £3.00

Soup & Sandwiches Add £5.00

3 Course Meal Option Add £3.00

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

A non-refundable deposit of £100 per party is required to confirm your reservation.

Provisional bookings are held for one calendar month after which time they may be offered to another visiting party.

Menu selections should be arranged and final numbers confirmed with the Club Steward/Caterer 4 days prior to the visit together with any special catering requirements.

Please note that food not cancelled within 48 hours will be charged on the final account.

Please let us know if you require nearest the pins & longest drives so that we can have them pre-positioned on the course for you.

On arrival, the Organiser should meet with the Club Secretary, Mark, or his assistant, Linda who will liaise on behalf of Knaresborough Golf Club.

The balance of any account must be settled in full on the day, prior to play, although payment by invoice may be pre-arranged in certain circumstances.

Each group/match should aim to play 18 holes in no more than 4 hours 20 minutes. One slow player can ruin the enjoyment of everybody else on the course. Please ensure that such a player is not amongst your members.

Format for play must be 3 or 4 ball in Stableford, Strokeplay, Am-Am or Foursomes. **Texas Scrambles are not permitted.**

Although handicap certificates are not required a reasonable standard of golf and good standard of etiquette are expected of all players. Experienced golf club members should be present in each playing group.

Visitors are strongly advised to check that they are adequately insured.

The Organiser of each group is responsible for ensuring that all his party know about dress code, mobile phone usage, pace of play, care of the golf course etc. Please ensure you pass on this information as it prevents any embarrassment on the day.
